ABOUT THE STUDY

Researchers at Osteopathy's Promise to Children are recruiting participants 4 months old and younger who are diagnosed with plagiocephaly for a research study that will examine how two different types of noninvasive therapies influence restoration of cranial symmetry and reduce flattening of the head.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

4 months old and younger at the time of enrollment
Plagiocephaly diagnosis by your healthcare provider
Access to San Diego outpatient clinic

PARTICIPATION INVOLVES

Attending 10 clinic visits total: 8 clinic visits for OMT and 2 cranial measurement visits and completing surveys on your infant's health. You will also be asked to do some exercises at home.
